- ✓ Do the scenes...
 - Show the appropriate level of challenge for the characters?
 - o Present clear conflicts that make sense?
 - o Show the hero failing and changing?

- o Show clear cause and effect btw actions emotions?
- o Pace well, spending enough time on the important events?
- ✓ Is the antagonist...
 - o Shown at the right times?
 - o Compelling & complex?
- ✓ Plot twists...
 - o Properly foreshadowed?
 - Significant to the main character & story problem?
- ✓ Climax...
 - As stressful for the characters as it could be?
 - Preceded by a "false climax"
 - o In the right place in the story?
- ✓ Resolution...
 - o Satisfying?
 - o Picking up the loose ends
 - o Fit the kind of story you've been telling?
 - o Consistent with your theme?

 - o Give the right details without unintentionally slowing the pace?
 - o Build a world easily the reader can understand
 - Clearly describe the action and the setting interactions?
 - o Fit with the character and the scene?
 - o Match the voice?
 - o Engage multiple senses?
 - o Rely on nouns rather than adjectives?
 - Use effective metaphors?
- ✓ Does the dialogue...
 - o Flow in a way that makes it easy to follow who's talking?
 - O Work alongside the action of the scene?
 - o Provide necessary information?
 - o Have rhythm?
 - o Layer different multiple of meaning?
 - O Work well with body language and nonverbal cues to tell the story?
